

# Contract for Private Parties at Manorlu

Manorlu members may hold private gatherings or parties at the swim club. **Off-Season Private Parties** are defined as any party occurring prior to the start of regular operating hours which DOES NOT require the club to be closed to membership. **In-Season Private Parties** are defined as any private party that closes the club to members during regular operating hours.

Pricing for both types of events include:

- a manager
- two lifeguards (or more for larger parties)
- full use of the facilities
- setup of up to six 8' tables with white or green pool chairs
- setup of shade tent on the sundeck, upon request

You may bring your own food and beverages however no glass containers are permitted on the Manorlu grounds.

Private Party Pricing is as follows:

Manorlu Pool and Private Party rules will be in effect during all private parties. It is the member/host's responsibility to ensure guests are aware of the rules and regulations.

Manorlu staff is on duty to supervise activity in the pool. Party hosts must provide adequate and attentive adult supervision for any and all children under the age of 18 attending the party. Non-member guests must complete Manorlu Liability Waiver.

Members using the facilities for a party are responsible for cleaning up all areas used for the party and placing all trash in the proper receptacles. The staff is not responsible for cleaning up after parties. For an additional fee, clean-up services are available.

### **Manorlu Pool Rules**

1. All swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
2. Running, wrestling, ball playing, etc. are forbidden on the pool apron, in the water or on the diving boards. GAMES MUST BE APPROVED BY THE POOL MANAGER.
3. No one will be permitted on the pool apron in street clothes.
4. Smoking, eating, drinking and gum chewing ARE NOT PERMITTED on the pool apron or in the water.
5. Admission to the pool and grounds may be denied to persons with skin abrasions or infections, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes or wearing bandages.
6. The deep end of the pool is reserved for diving only. If you use the boards, swim clear of them to the closest ladder as soon as your dive is completed. Do not dive or swim under the diving boards at any time. Swimming under the ropes is not permitted. Unsafe behavior will not be tolerated.
7. Only one person will be allowed on the diving board at one time. For the diving board, waiting divers must remain on the apron until the previous divers have entered the water.
8. Multiple bouncing on the diving boards is prohibited.
9. Floating aids are not permitted in the main pool. Flotation devices are permitted every Thursday evening during Tube Night. Flotation devices are permitted during private parties.
10. The pool apron must be kept clear of blankets, chairs, playpens or any other obstructions.
11. The lifeguards are present for your protection. Talking and loitering at the stands diverts their attention and is therefore prohibited.
12. The volleyball pit is for volleyball only. A sand box is available for playing. Before entering the pool, rinse grass, sand and/or dirt from your feet and body. Facilities for such rinsing are provided.
13. MAKESHIFT bathing trunks INCLUDING CUT-OFFS will not be permitted in the pool.
14. Members must clean their area at ALL TIMES and place all waste material, including cigarette and cigar butts in the containers provided. THIS INCLUDES THE AREA AROUND THE SNACK BAR.
15. The safety steps are provided as a service to members who cannot use the regular ladders. Sitting, standing, loitering or any other use is prohibited.
16. Bicycles, skateboards, skates, scooters, etc. are not permitted on the grounds at any time.

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
